10.45am We move back into the main hall where we will have transformed the play area to 3 craft stations for the little ones to enjoy and get messy!! One craft will be based on the story just read, while one will be on what is happening soon, like Father's Day, Easter, or Christmas and the final one will be a great messy sensory experience, so don't come in Sunday best clothes!!

11.15am We will move the tables to the side and warm up our vocal pipes with a singalong. Singing all the greats from sleeping bunnies to hokey cokey to if I were a butterfly and He's got the whole world in his hands.

We will end the session at 11.25 with a goodbye song and bubbles to take us to 11.30am where hopefully your little one will be happy and sleepy after a morning of play and fun with you.
